PRODUCTION TECHNIQUE:

The grapes are carefully selected by hand during a 20-25 day harvest in estate-vineyards. Each of the 12 single-vineyards is studied for the optimal harvesting moment, as the winery can rely on a crew of 200 workers. The grapes are subsequently softly pressed and fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel vats for 15-18 days. Then, the wine is left to rest for several months in temperature controlled stainless steel vats to produce complexity on the palate and ripeness on the nose. A 30-day bottle rest follows.

TASTING NOTES:

Pale straw yellow in colour with jade hues during the first months. An intense bouquet of peach, apple and roses, all characteristics of the noble Verdicchio grape! A refreshing palate with a pleasant bitter almond finish. Enjoy within two years as an aperitif, with shellfish, sushi or marinated poultry.

ACCODALES: 85 points -Wine Spectator (Web Only - 2008)

Aromas of cooked apple and honey follow through to a full body, with apple tart flavors and a medium finish. Drink now.
